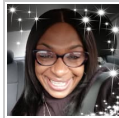

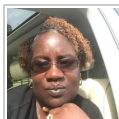

Ten years without you has taught me how much one person can impact a life forever. Though you're no longer here in the way I wish you were, your love hasn't gone anywhere. It still holds me up when I feel like falling. It still reminds me who I am and where I come from. And most of all, it reminds me that even though you're gone, you'll never truly be absent from my life. You are, and always will be, my dad—and I miss you every single day.
