February 9, 1953 - October 19, 2013

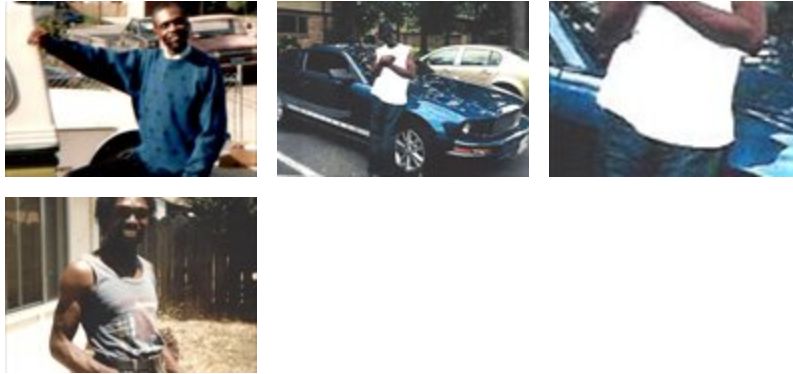
Barry A. Kidd was born in Marietta, Georgia on February 9, 1953, to Nathaniel Kidd, Sr. and Dorothy Kidd. As a military family, they were stationed at Travis AFB in Fairfield, California. The Kidd family traveled to many places including Hahn AFB in Germany. The family made Fairfield, California its final home during the remaining years of his father's military service. Barry graduated from Armijo High School in Fairfield, California in 1972. After graduating, he followed the footsteps of his father and pursued a military career enlisting in the U.S. Army. He also served in many places including Germany, Ft. Steward, Ft. McPherson, and Ft. Ord. Barry entered into marriage with Beverly Jean Brown where together they birthed two children; Barry Alonzo, who died months after birth and a daughter; Jeaninna Kamera Kidd. Later he entered into a 34-year marriage to Sandra Clark and they became parents to Barry, Zandra, and Terrance Kidd. They resided in Fairfield, California for 12 years. Barry and his family were members of Mt. Calvary Baptist Church in Suisun City, California, the same church as his parents where Barry served as a musician playing the drums until they relocated to Newport News, Virginia where the family has remained to this day. Barry was employed by the Great Wolf Lodge in Williamsburg, Virginia at the time of his passing. Barry went to be with the Lord on October 19, 2013 following a brief illness. He is preceded in death by his infant son; Barry Alonzo, his father; Nathaniel Kidd, Sr., mother; Dorothy Marie Kidd, and a daughter; Zandra Constance Kidd.
