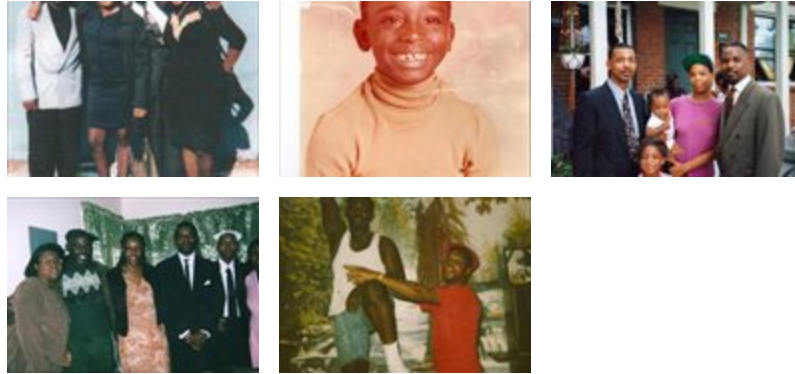
The body will be placed in church two hours prior to the service.
