Viewing will be held from 1:00 until 7:00 pm on Friday, October 30, 2009 at the

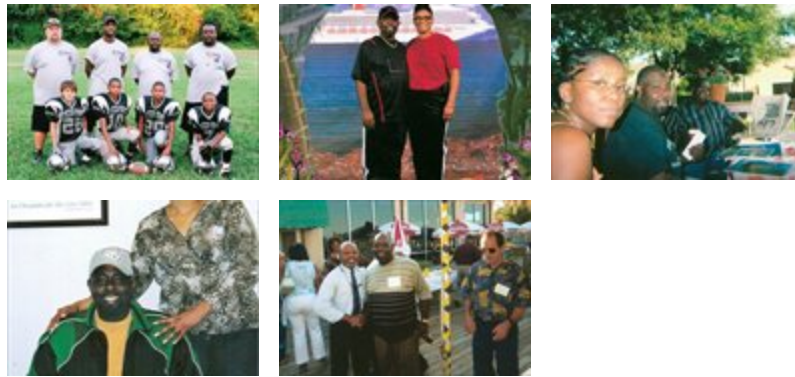
funeral home and two hours prior at the church.
