Ms. Carolyn Glover, 71, of Newport News, VA, passed away peacefully at home in her daughter's arms, on September 20, 2021. She was born on April 10, 1950, in Birmingham, Alabama.

Carolyn completed her Bachelor's Degree in Primary Education at Bishop College, and then went on to achieve her Master's Degree in Guidance Counseling at the University of Alabama, Birmingham. She worked as a Middle School teacher and guidance counselor in Newport News and Hampton public school system. One of her greatest passions in life was education and spreading love through knowledge to every student she encountered.

Carolyn was a trained vocalist and gifted singer whose voice would bring joy to anyone who heard her. She had a very powerful alto range that was distinct and stood out in any arena. Music was a high part of her essence, and her love for the performing arts exuded through her daily life.

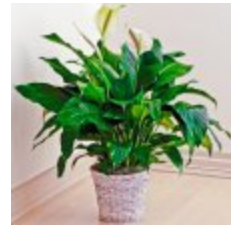
