Smith, Bernice Tatum, Etta (Ray) Porter, and a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.

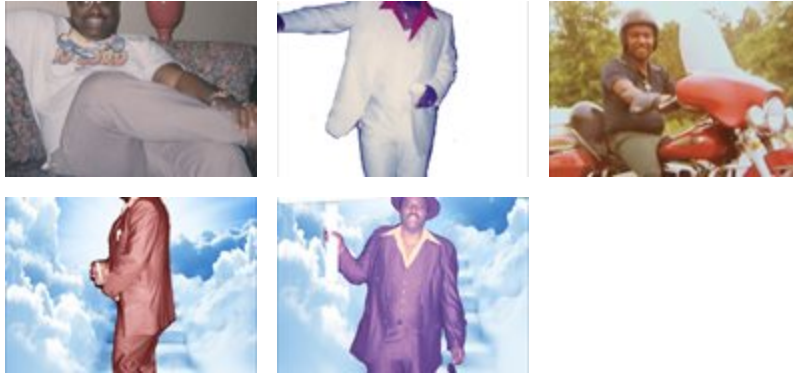
A viewing will be held on Tuesday, September 10, 2013 from 12 pm until 6 pm.
