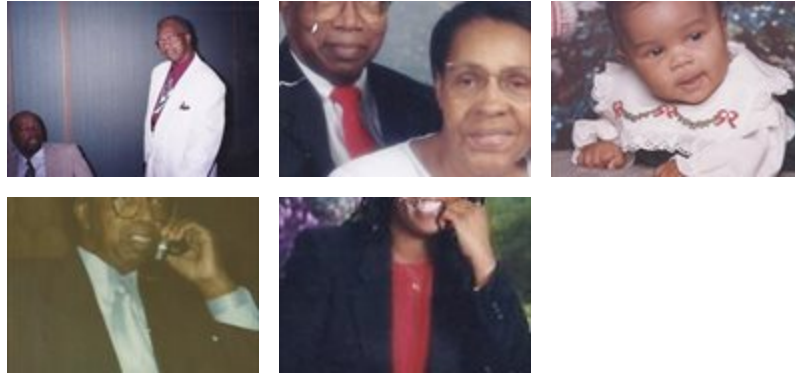
Viewing will be held on Thursday, April 26th from 12 noon until 6:00 pm at the funeral home and 2 hours prior at the church.
