He attended school in Newport News, and Hampton, VA.

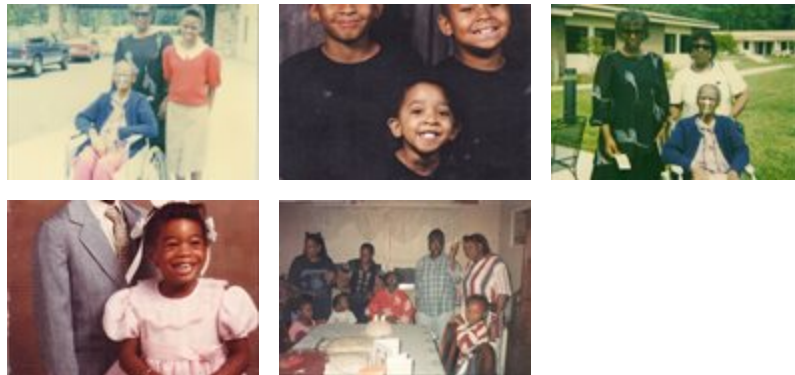
