On Wednesday, August 3, 2022, David W. Moore transitioned peacefully into eternal rest while in his home in South Chesterfield, VA, where he was lovingly supported by his family. David was born in Jarratt, VA, on November 1, 1940, to the late Frank Wilbert and Susie Alma Moore.

As a young man, he was baptized at Morning Star Baptist Church, Jarratt, VA. He later joined Union Branch Baptist Church, Prince George, VA, with his family in the late 70s. David was a God-fearing man, who always had "the faith to be healed," and he believed taking care of his family was an act of worship and service to God; and "Oh, how he served!"

In addition to his parents, David was preceded in death by four brothers, Willie Lee Moore, James Moore, John Moore and Barnie Moore; two brothers-in-law, Rev. Michael Scott and Rev. Clarence B. Diggs; and three sisters-in-law, Shirley Moore, Muriel Moore, and Mary Ruth Moore.

David attended Sussex County public schools and was known as "Wendell" to some, and "Chin" to others. He cherished all those who were near and dear to him, and he never met a stranger. David left Jarratt, moved to Baltimore, MD, and later moved to Brooklyn, New York, where he met and married his wife of fifty-seven (57) years, Ermitrude "Trudy" Scott on April 17, 1965. They lived in Brooklyn, New York, until moving to Chesterfield, VA in 1974. They built their forever home and move to Prince George, VA in 1975. After multiple debilitating health challenges, David and Trudy moved to South Chesterfield to live with their daughter and son-in-law in 2016.

David worked as a Mail Handler for the United States Post Office for thirty-nine (39) years, only retiring due to his health challenges. He always said he wanted to retire after forty-three years (not sure why that was the magic number, but he would have been seventy years old). He was a Masterful opponent in Bowling, Golf, and Shooting Pool. He earned a plethora of trophies, badges, plaques and newspaper clippings to show for it.

He leaves to cherish his memory his loving and devoted wife of 57 years, Ermitrude Moore; one loving and devoted daughter, Melanie Thompson (Chris - a loving and devoted son-in-law) of South Chesterfield, VA; one loving and devoted granddaughter, Mishanda McFarlane (Mosiah - a loving and devoted grandson-in-law) of Prince George, VA; one great-granddaughter, Miyah McFarlane of Prince George, VA; two step-grandsons, Blake and Matthew Thompson; one step-great-granddaughter, Charleigh Thompson; one brother, Ernest "Mut" Moore of Jarratt, VA; one sister, Mamie "Boote" Diggs of Honeybrook, PA; three sisters-in-law, Mildred Radcliff (Peter, Sr.) of Petersburg, VA, Louise Moore of Edgewood, MD, and Katie Ray of Bear, DE; one raised as a sister, Linda Moore of Washington, DC; and a host of loving nieces, nephews, great nieces, great nephews, cousins, extended family, friends, and devoted neighbors. He was forever grateful for all the family, friends, and neighbors that supported him and his family during his health

challenges.

He will be missed by all who knew and loved him; as he was fondly known as a man with a "beautiful soul!"

David was also a very clever man, including in his transition during COVID; with that in mind, we are honoring his wishes not to have a public viewing or a home going service.
