



Mr. Dennis "Sonny" M Williams

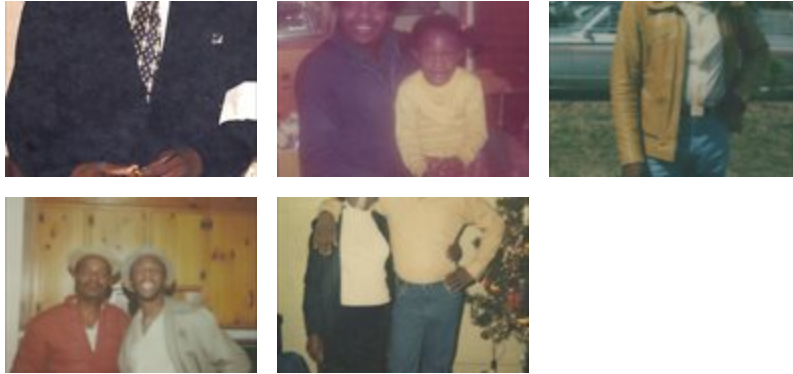
December 6, 1950 - September 23, 2012
