



## Reverend Diane Demetrius Miller

September 19, 1955 - February 13, 2020

Diane Demetrius Chester Miller was born on September 19, 1955, to Mary Taylor Chester and the late Jack Chester. After a long illness and a courageous fight, she departed this life on February 13, 2020, at Hampton Sentara Hospital.

She graduated from Ferguson High School in June 1973, later retiring from Norfolk Naval Shipyard after 42 years of service.

She gave her life to the Lord and joined Temple of Peace Church in 1994 where she devoted her time and energy serving others. She served as custodian, church & financial secretary, usher, president of the food ministry and singles ministry, Sunday school teacher, superintendent of Sunday school and Preacher. She is a living sacrifice of what ONLY God can do. She went from scrubbing the floors of his church to preaching the Word in his church. She received her license to preach on January 18, 2004, and she has been a faithful servant on her earthly journey. She devoted herself to her family, friends and Godly service. She was admired as a role model by those aspiring to follow her footsteps.

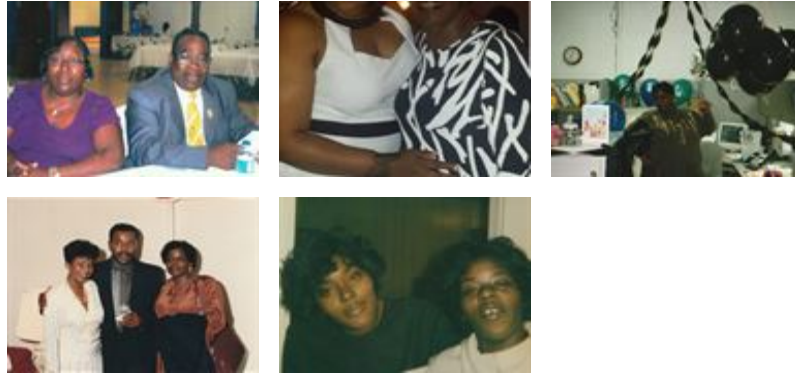

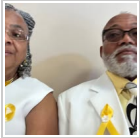
