Earl D. Savage II, 57 was born March 30, 1962, in Newport News, Virginia. Earl was the 2nd child to Earl Delester and Jean Naomi Boswell Savage. During his school years he was always active in sports, including basketball, football, and track and field and excelled at them all.
