Retired Master Sergeant Edna J. Williams, 66, was called home to be with the Lord on December 8, 2020 at North Las Vegas VA Medical Center, Las Vegas, Nevada. She was born April 5, 1954 in Petersburg, VA to the late Rev. Ernest J. Johnson and Mrs. Vera R. Johnson.

Edna graduated from Petersburg High School Class of 1972. She later went on to the University of Phoenix where she graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Human Services. She retired from the U. S. Air Force after twenty years of service. Edna was a member of Zion Baptist Church, Petersburg, VA, while under the leadership of Rev. Dr. Andrew J. White, Sr.

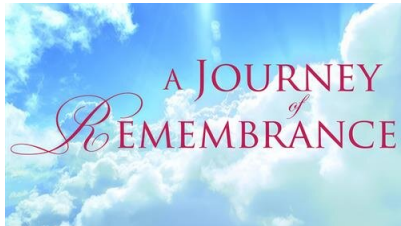

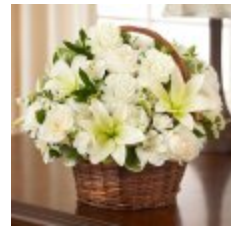
