November 24, 1959 - November 9, 2009

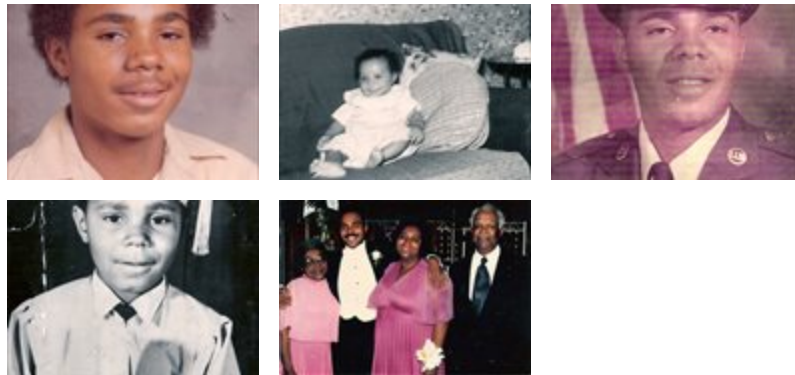
