God Blessed Our Family with Eric's quiet presence. Eric is at peace in the in the presense of God.

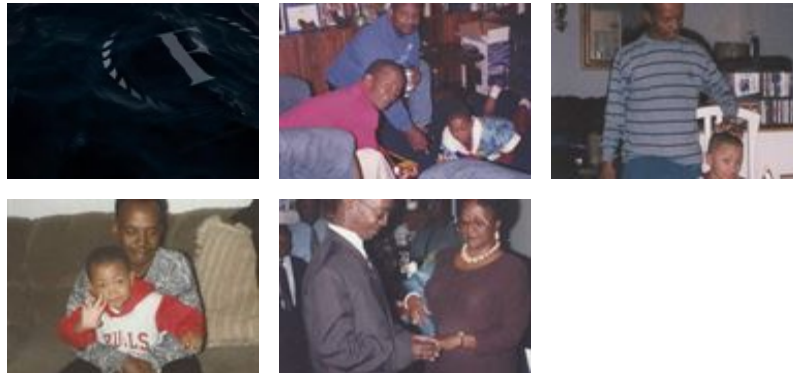
