Eva attended Philadelphia Public Schools and graduated from Simon Gratz High School in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania Class of 1965. She worked at Stanley Blacker Clothing Factory for 13 years and then decided to further her education by attending Temple University School of Social Work where she graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree (B.S) in 1980.
