



Deacon Fannie Fitzgerald Brown

July 29, 1940 - January 22, 2021

Deacon Fannie F. Brown, the third eldest born to the late Theodore Roosevelt Fitzgerald, Sr., and Susie Fitzgerald, was preceded in death by her husband, John E. Brown; two sisters, Flonia Fitzgerald and Mary Jones and brother, Theodore Roosevelt Fitzgerald, Jr.

Fannie joined Mount Zion RZUA Church, Blackstone, VA at an early age. She was a graduate of Luther H. Foster High School. She was a member of Trinity Baptist Church in Petersburg, VA, until moving to Blackstone, VA, where she joined Shiloh Baptist Church and became a member of the Deaconess Board. She also served as the president of the Missionary Board until resigning. Fannie was a former member of the Petersburg Chapter of the Eastern Star. Fannie was a retired employee of Allied Chemical at the Chesterfield Plant, now known as Honeywell.
