Mr. Watts memories will be cherished and remembered by his children, many relatives, friends, and co-workers.

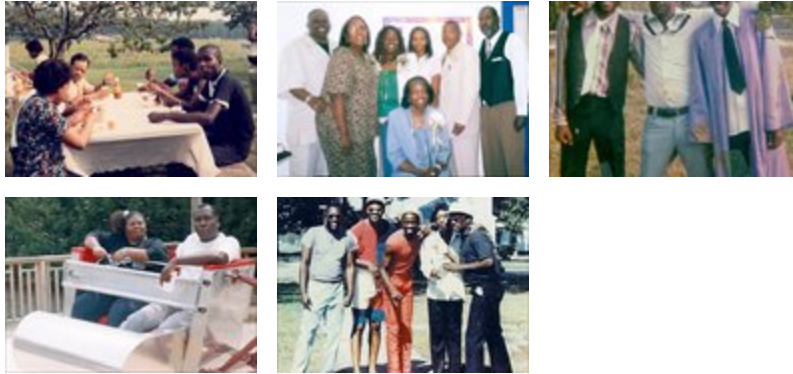
A viewing will be held on Monday, October 21, 2013 from 1:00 until 5:00 pm.
