December 22, 1926 - December 20, 2012

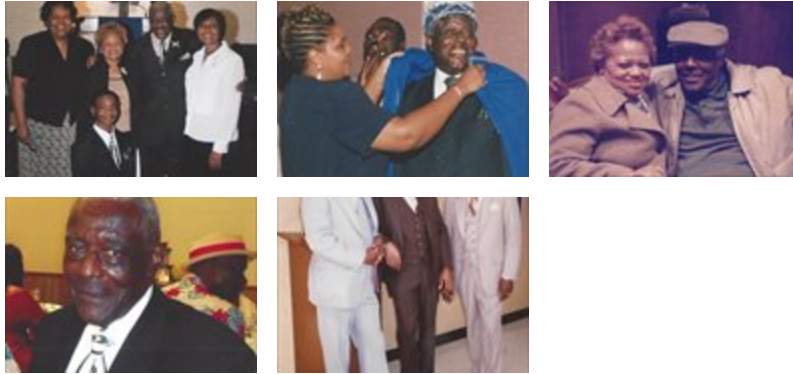
