Mrs. Glenda Bell Frazier of Chester, Virginia passed away on August 19, 2022, surrounded by the love of her family. Glenda's smile was infectious and radiated her love for God.

Passionate about serving people, Glenda attained her Bachelor of Social Work from Methodist University and Master of Social Work at Virginia Commonwealth University, Richmond, VA.
