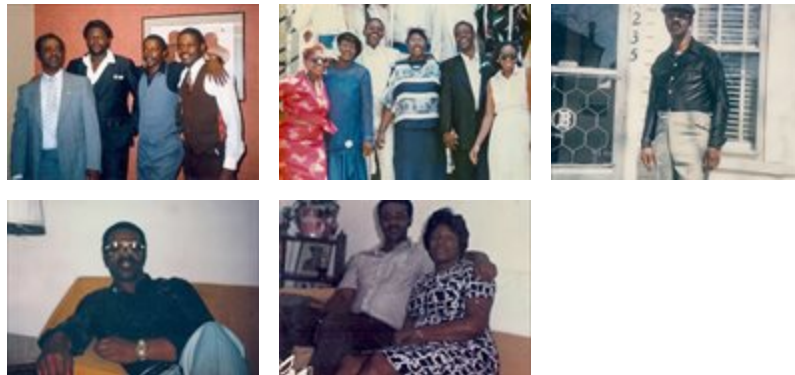
host of grandchildren, great grandchildren, great-great grandchildren, nieces, nephews; and other relatives and friends.
