July 16, 1937 - October 30, 2010

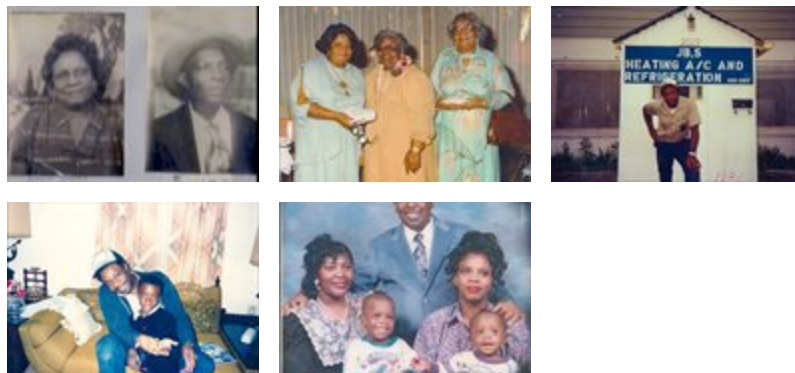
