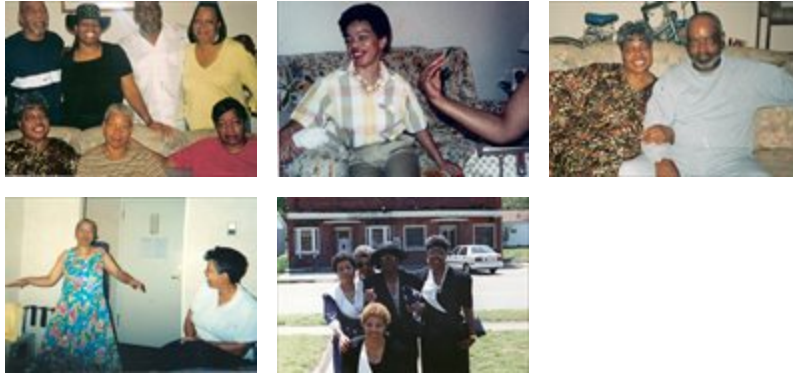
The family also wants to extend a special Thank You to Riverside Hospice.
