at Ivy Baptist Church, 50 Maple Avenue, Newport News.

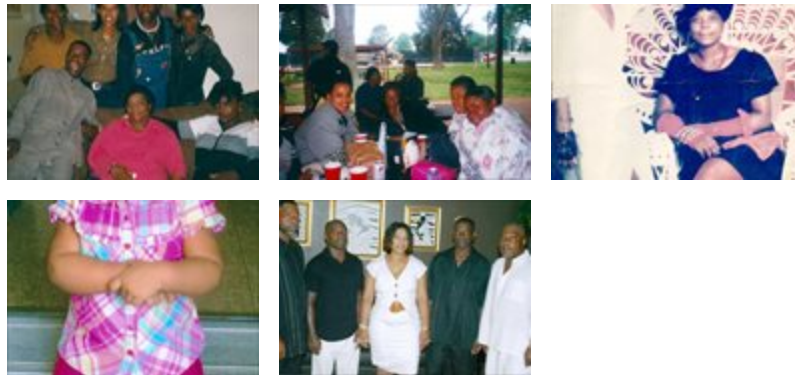
Interment to follow in Greenlawn Memorial Park. Viewing will be from 1 - 6 p.m. Wednesday, August 10, 2011 at the funeral home.
