She was educated in the Newport News Public School System and a 1961 Viking of Huntington High School. Later that year, she went to work for the Newport News School System and retired in 2011 when her health no longer permitted her to do so. She volunteered and participated in a lot of programs that were fun, educational and beneficial for the residents; not only in Dickerson Courts, but Harbor Homes, Ridley Circle and Lassiter Drive.
