He attended the La Boca Jr. High School where he met Sislin Trotman who later became his wife on June 21, 1959. Three wonderful children emerged from that union; Gregory, Virgilio & Michelle.

He worked at the Tocumen International Airport as a Sales Clerk at one of the Duty-Free stores before relocating to the U.S. where he lived with his Aunt Verona (deceased) and cousin Vilma Small Hennigan.

Lenny was gifted with a voice for signing which he enjoyed doing. He was the lead singer with the Willie Morro's Orchestra that played for dances & other activities. He was dubbed with the, (Nat Cole of Panama) a name he felt proud to be called. This was before migrating to the U.S.

Lenny was employed at the U.S. Federal Bankruptcy Court New York as a

Procurement Administrator, retiring from there on August 31, 2006.

In 2015, Lenny relocated to Hampton VA, where he could be closer to his daughter Michelle. He enjoyed his stay in VA where he made lots of friends, even being dubbed as "Big Daddy".

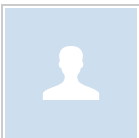

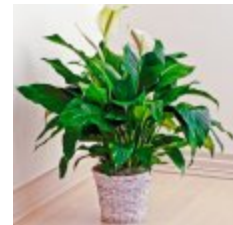
