On September 16, 1972, Linda was joined in holy matrimony to the late Clifton Ray Chapman. They were married for 37 years and were the surrogate parents for many children, especially their nieces and nephews.

Linda graduated in the 1968 Class of Huntington High School. After graduation, Linda's first job was as a CNA at Patrick Henry Hospital. She would later move to Riverside Hospital, where she worked for over 36 years in the Sterile Processing Department.

She retired in 2013 as a Central Processing Technician at Riverside Regional Medical Center. Her unofficial title should have been "Riverside Goodwill Ambassador" because everywhere she went there was someone that remembered her from the job and had an engaging story to share. She was a member of International Association of Healthcare Central Service Materiel Management (IAHCSMM)] now the Healthcare Sterile Processing Association (HSPA).

late Reverend Sidney W. Williams, Sr. Over the last 60 plus years, she served the church in many capacities and was instrumental in many ministries.

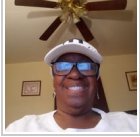
