Malik received his education from Achievable Dreams Academy in Newport News, VA. His interests were music, chess and baseball.

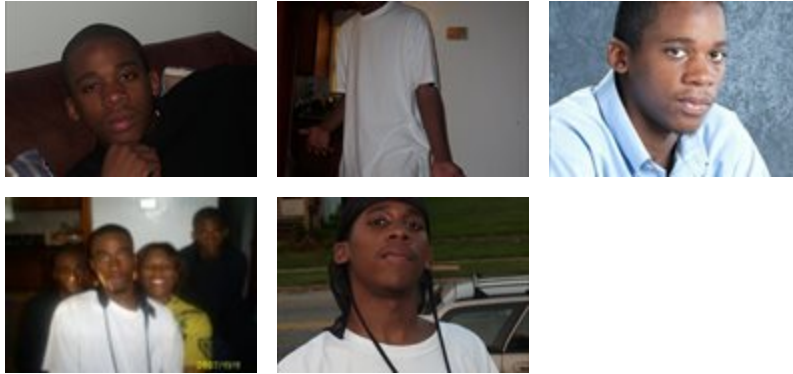
