Margaret Jean Anthony Jackson was born on August 13, 1937 to the late Eugene and Lucretia Anthony in Long Island, NY. She departed from her labor on June 18, 2022 surrounded by her loving family at 5:30 P.M. in Chippenham Hospital Center, Richmond, Virginia.

After settling in Virginia, Margaret became a member of the Oak Grove Baptist Church, pastored by Rev. Dr. Earl Thompson. Prior to that, she was a faithful member of the Bibleway Community Church, Central Islip, NY, pastored by Bishop Larry T. Marshall.

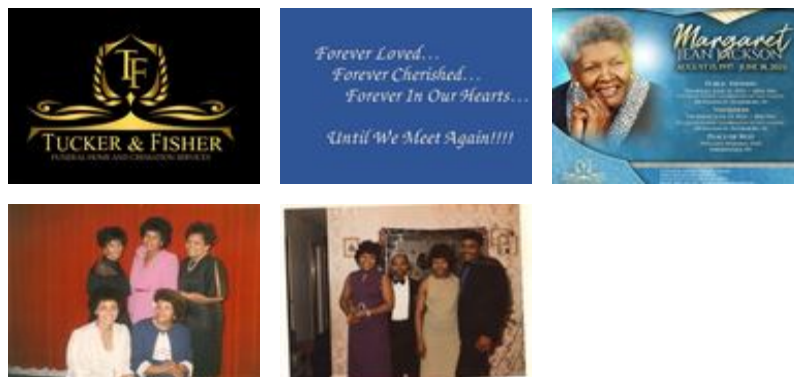
