Marjorie was born on July 22, 1937 to the late Richard Sylvester Banks and Bertha Allen Banks in Norfolk, Virginia and received her formal education in the Norfolk Public School System.

Marjorie met the love of her life, Clyde Epps, Sr., when she was eight years of age and he was eleven. The couple entered holy matrimony on November 5, 1955 and celebrated 53 years of marriage.
