Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses at 804 41st Street Newport News, Virginia, 23607.

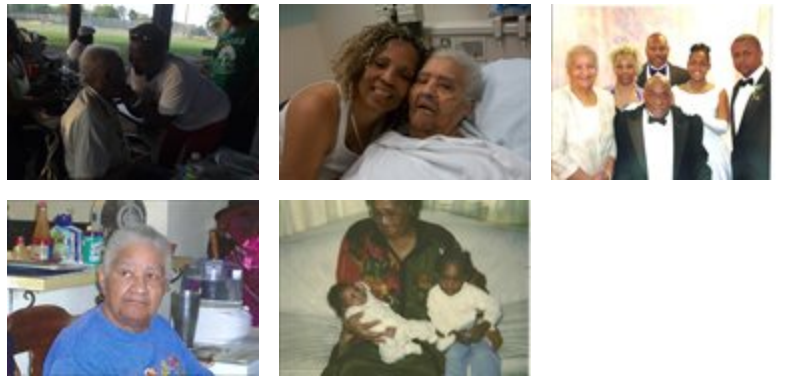
