



Michael Lassiter

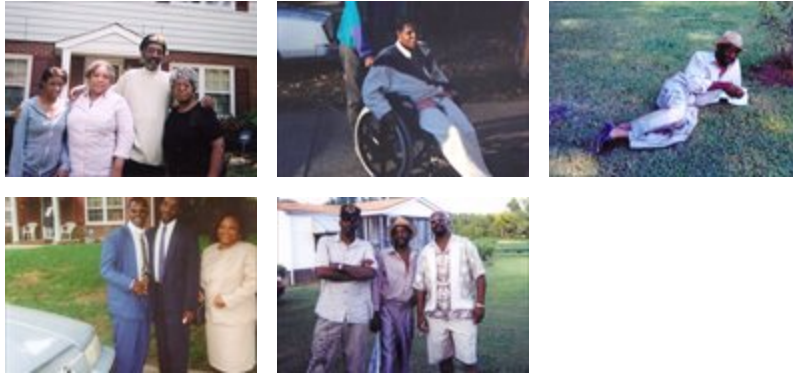
April 4, 1954 - May 23, 2009
