Monica graduated from Girls High School in 1980. She began working at Mellon Bank in 1983 where she met the love of her life, Theodore Stockman. They married on July 28, 1984. She worked for Mellon Bank from 1983 to 1998 and then began her career with Social Security Administration as a VHR contractor. She landed a permanent position at the Elkins Park office in Pennsylvania. Due to changes in Monica's health and the loss of her parents, she moved to Charlotte, North Carolina and attended Elevation Church and participated in Egroup meetings.

Monica's smile could light up a room. She loved to travel and enjoyed cooking, especially Sunday dinners. Having the family together was very important to her. She loved her nieces and nephews as her own children.

Monica was preceded in death by her devoted husband of 20 years, Theodore Stockman; her parents, Lois Johnson and Creed Johnson; and her brother, Marty Johnson.
