Paul James Cameron Sr. was born on Tuesday, November 21, 1989, at Hartford Hospital in Hartford, CT to Paul H. Cameron Sr. and Vanessa Brown.

James was a happy and energetic baby. He was the joy of our family. At an early age, James became fascinated with the ministry. At the grand old age of 2, he was often found preaching in the mirror at home using a towel as a robe and a hairbrush for his mic. Even though you couldn't understand what he was saying, he had the "hoop" down pat as he stomped his feet and wiped his forehead with a washcloth. He'd shout out, "Let the church say Amen!" Paul also loved music. He would play pots, pans, and lids like drums with wooden spoons while he watched the Bobby Jones Gospel Show.

Paul sat beside his parents at the piano and organ from infancy and watched them play for various choirs and churches. This led him to love music and eventually know the Lord for himself. He first started out as a drummer playing for numerous churches and then later developed a love for playing the keyboard. The ear that God gave him for music was phenomenal and his playing matured quickly in various music styles, gospel being his favorite. Paul was respected for his dedication, punctuality, and musical creative genius with all the churches and artists that he played for and worked with.

Paul served as minister of music for a few churches in the Hampton Roads

Area over the course of 15 years. His last ministry assignment was at Little Grove Baptist Church in Suffolk, VA where Ralph Richardson III is Senior Pastor.

Paul's childhood education started at the Northeastern Adventist Academy, Harford Campus. He later matriculated through the Bloomfield, Connecticut public school system until he was 16 years old. He then moved to Norfolk, VA, and graduated from Granby High School. He continued his education and earned an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Tidewater Community College in Norfolk, VA.

Some of Paul's interests include barbering, stylish dressing, cars, songwriting, music shedding, and praise and worship. He opened for gospel artists such as Ben Tankard, Anthony Brown & Group Therapy, and a host of other music ministries. Even though he had many opportunities to play for secular artists, Paul made the decision early on in his life to only give his gifts to the Lord. Paul loved his family. He was a dedicated husband and father who worked to provide and care for his family.

On August 20, 2022, Paul released his first single. These are the words he wrote on his single:

"Here's an early listen to my new single. I've been through so much and I wanted to put out some music that's geared toward taking your mind off of whatever problems or pain that you're going through. This is my testimony, but I hope it blesses you as well."

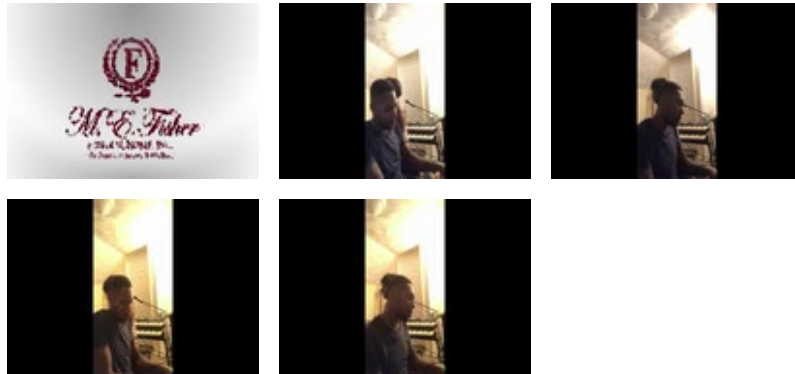
