



Mr. Ray "Danny" Gilliam

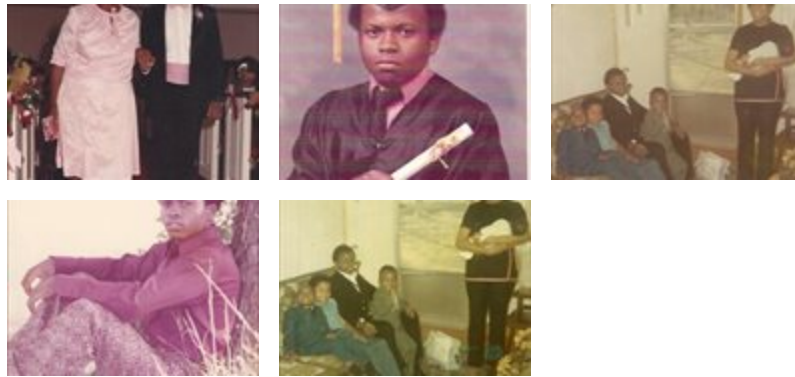
April 21, 1956 - March 20, 2013
