Ms. Sarah Ann Clark, 54, departed this life peacefully on Sunday, September 12, 2021 at Bon Secours - Southside Medical Center, Petersburg, Virginia. Sarah was born on July 8, 1967 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia, but later moved to Chesterfield County, Virginia where she was raised and reared at the Children's Home of Virginia Baptist. Sarah was baptized at an early age at Rocky Mount Baptist Church, Skipwith, VA. She attended Shiloh Baptist Church while at the Children's Home, where she was an usher and sang in the choir. Sarah was a 1987 graduate of Matoaca High School in Chesterfield, Virginia.
