Thomas Cunningham Jr., better known as "Fat Man" of Newport News, peacefully answered the master's call on Friday, February 7, 2020. He was born on September 17, 1977, to the late Geraldine Rosser- Cunningham and Thomas Cunningham Sr.

Born and raised in Newport News, as a child, he spent his time in worship at the United House of Prayer for all People under the leadership of Mother Whitaker, with his maternal grandmother, brother and cousin Tameka Hillian who was like a sister (with whom he resided). He was educated in the Newport News Public School System where he attended Warwick High School and had tons of friends.

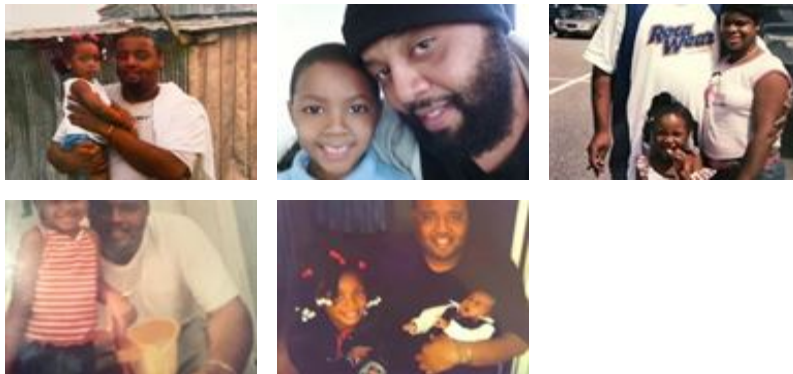
