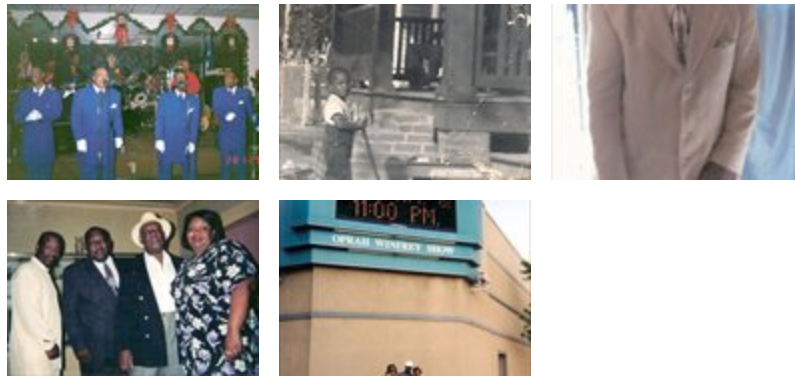
he just continued to talk to God about it.
