



## Mrs. Vernell Fauntleroy

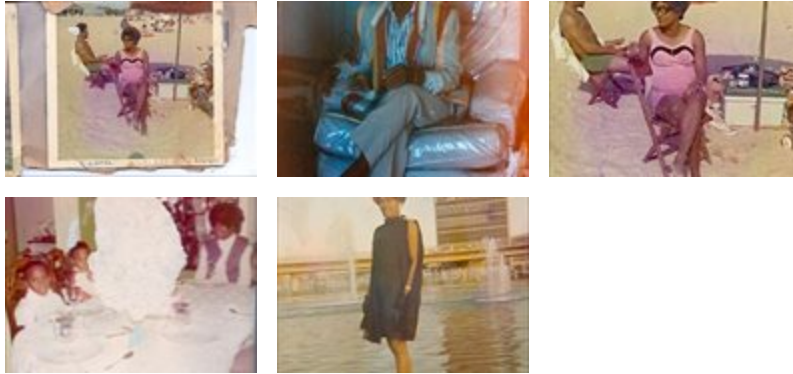
July 28, 1932 - October 10, 2011
