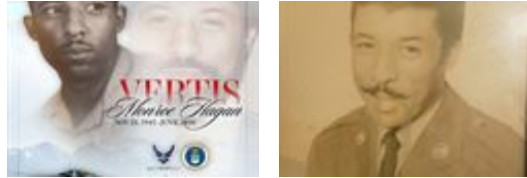
Vertis was a good guy... someone you could count on!

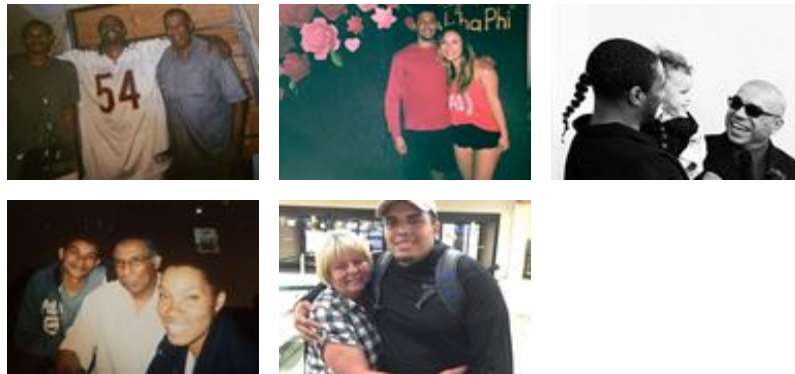

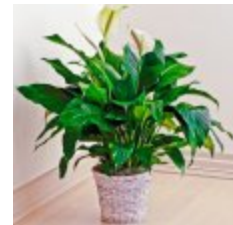
