



## Mr. William Alexander Jones

April 28, 1952 - December 11, 2024

Mr. William Alexander Jones, beloved father, grandfather, son, brother, uncle, nephew, and friend transitioned peacefully on December 11, 2024. His legacy of joy and great sense of humor will leave us with eternal cherished memories. William was born on April 28, 1952, to William and Eleanor Jones at Whitaker Memorial Hospital in Newport News, VA. He was the youngest of two children. "Boo" as he was affectionately called, attended Tiny Tots Kindergarten, Booker T. Washington Elementary, Walter Reed Elementary, Dunbar Elementary, Huntington High School, and Norfolk State University.

William worked across the peninsula to include the Hampton Roads Boys Club, Avon Fashion Company, Basic Construction Company, and Newport News Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company (currently Huntington Ingalls) and Rivermont Alternative School from which he retired after fourteen years of dedicated service.

He was preceded in death by his parents, William and Eleanor Jones, and grandson, Jesus Hamilton.

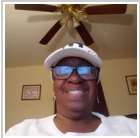

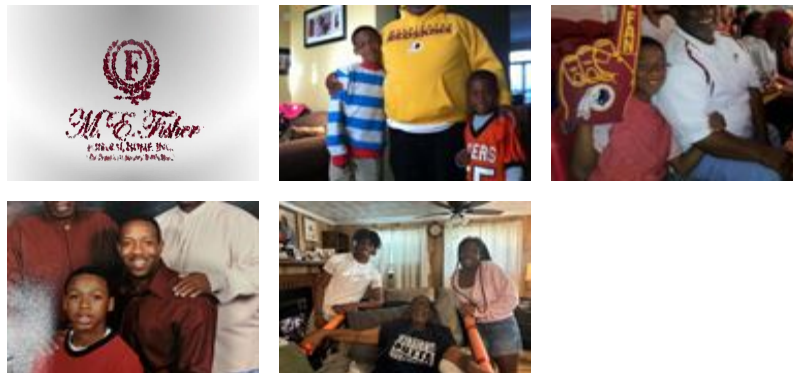
